The Children's Oral Health Initiative is a First Nations Health Authority initiative designed to prevent and control tooth decay and other oral diseases in young First Nations children.

JOB DUTIES:

- Under the instruction and direction of a dental professional:
- Delivers education sessions on dental health for a parent or caregiver of children – newborn to 7 years' old
- Applies fluoride varnish to children's teeth (training is provided)
- Provides instruction on tooth brushing and general oral hygiene practices
- Administers forms, records and takes care of supplies
- Assists dental professional (dental therapist, dental hygienist, dentist) as necessary
- Visits parents/ caregivers in homes
